Report on Review of Interim Condensed Consolidated Financial Information to the Board of Directors

Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying interim condensed consolidated statement of Financial Position of Gulf Petroleum Investment Company K.S.C.C, "Parent Company" and its subsidiaries (collectively referred to as "the Group") as of 30 June 2010 and the related interim condensed consolidated statements of income, comprehensive income, changes in equity and cash flows for the six-month period then ended. The Parent Company management is responsible for the preparation and presentation of this interim condensed consolidated financial information in accordance with IAS (34) "Interim Financial Reporting". Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on this interim condensed consolidated financial information based on our review.

Scope of Review

We conducted our review in accordance with International Standard on Review Engagements 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity."

A review of interim condensed consolidated financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with International Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Conclusion

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying interim condensed consolidated financial information are not presented fairly, in all material respects, in accordance with International Accounting Standard No. "34" - Interim Financial Reporting.

Emphasis of Matter


Without qualifying our conclusion mentioned above, we draw attention to note (2) to this interim condensed consolidated financial information, as the Group's current liabilities exceeded its current assets as of 30 June 2010. The Group's ability to settle its liabilities depends on the success of implementing the plans that have been established to provide the necessary liquidity.

Report on Review of Other Legal and Regulatory Requirements

Further, based on our review, the interim condensed consolidated financial information is in agreement with the books of the Parent Company. To the best of our knowledge and belief, no violations of the Commercial Companies Law of 1960, as amended, or of the Parent Company's Articles of Association have occurred during the period ended 30 June 2010 that might have a material affect on the business of the Group or on its consolidated financial position except as follows:-

- We refer to note (4) to this financial information, as the Parent Company invested directly in shares and not through investment portfolios managed by specialized companies.
- We refer to note (6) to this financial information, as the Parent Company received loans and bank facilities with traditional terms and not in accordance to Islamic Sharia.

These are in contravention to the Parent Company's approved activities.

1. Incorporation and activities

Gulf Petroleum Investment Company K.S.C.C (the Parent Company) was incorporated in 1998 under the Kuwaiti's Law of Commercial Companies. The Parent Company operates according to the Noble Islamic Shariaa principles.

The main objectives of the Parent company and its subsidiaries (together referred to as "the Group") is to carry out oil field and gas services in land and sea, providing technical, economic, consulting, and marketing studies and in all fields related to oil and petrochemicals in addition to owning plants, machinery and tools necessary for oil and petrochemicals industry, and leasing them to others.

The Parent Company's registered office is at Salhiya, Ali Al Salem Street, Al-Mabaneer Building 1, first floor P.O. Box 14214 Fiha, 72853 Kuwait.

The International Investment Group (K.S.C.) holds 23.09% of the Parent Company's share capital as of 30 June 2010 (27.99% as of 31 December 2009, 14.53% as of 30 June 2009).

The interim condensed consolidated financial information was authorized for issue by the Board of Directors on 12 August 2010.

2. Basis of preparation condensed financial information

This interim condensed consolidated financial information has been prepared in accordance with International Accounting Standard (34), applicable to Interim Financial Reporting.

Interim condensed consolidated financial information does not include all the information and disclosures required for complete financial statements prepared in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards.

In the opinion of the management, all adjustments consisting of normal recurring accruals considered necessary for a fair presentation have been include, in the condensed consolidation financial information.

The operating results for the Six months period ended 30 June 2010 are not necessarily indicative of the results that may be expected for the year ending 31 December 2010. For further information, refer to the consolidated financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2009 and its related disclosures.

The interim condensed consolidated financial information have been prepared in accordance with the same accounting principles and methods of calculation used in the latest annual financial statements, except of the following:

Following is the most significant changes in the accounting policies on the Group:

- The acquisition-related cost is charged to the statement of income in the periods in which the costs are incurred.
- Changes in the interest of a subsidiary that will not result in loss of control are treated as group's equity transactions and they are accounted in equity.
- The interest held before obtaining control is re-measured at fair value at the date of obtaining control and the resulting gain or loss are charged to the statement of income.

There is no significant impact on the interim condensed consolidated financial information from these changes.

As of 30 June 2010, the current liabilities exceed the current assets with an amount of KD 5,922,995. In order to solve this issue, the Group is under negotiation with some financial institution in order to obtain long term Islamic finance and with some creditors to reschedule the debts.

The addition include an amount of KD 837,791 which represent the rigs dry dock ended during the current period and was capitalized on the related items of the property, plant and equipments.

- Available for sale investments represent unquoted local shares amounted to KD 460,855. Impairment in value was recorded for available for sale investments in full during the year ended 31 December 2009.
- The available for sale investment represent direct investments in shares. The Parent Company activities do not include direct investment, currently the corrective action is under process.

- Loans are granted against the pledge of the Rig. projects under progress, and the Parent Company's investment in Pyramid Drilling International Company Limited (Subsidiary) and the assignment of the rig's revenue to the bank.
- The Group borrows from traditional banks, and now the Group is in the process to transfer such borrowing to be in accordance with Islamic Shariaa.
- Current borrowings include an amount of KD 582,600 represents loans installments matured and not yet paid as of 30 June 2010. An installment of KD 466,080 was paid in the subsequent period of the financial position date.
